Philosophy & Goal

We believe that preschool should give each child a chance to be a child and to grow at his or her own pace physically, intellectually, emotionally, socially, and spiritually.

Our program curriculum is carefully planned to provide an enjoyable learning experience which meets the developmental needs of children three to five years of age. There is a balance between free play and structured learning times with active and quiet, structured and unstructured activities.



Group size & staff

Our preschool is licensed to serve 20 children per class with a staff/child ratio of 1:10. Our staff is certified in early childhood education by the Department of Human Services. Teachers are able to give attention to each individual child and to encourage him/her to develop responsibility, to learn to think and act independently, and to be considerate of others. Conferences with parents are scheduled twice yearly.



Our teachers are warm and loving. They continue to develop new interests and skills to help foster a love and excitement for learning and a positive attitude toward school.



Standards

Our state licensed school complies with the standards set forth by the State of Minnesota Department of Human Services. It is a non-profit school under the supervision of St. Luke's Lutheran Church.



Program

St. Luke's Christian Preschool provides experiences in a Christian environment which contribute to the physical, intellectual, emotional, social and spiritual growth of each preschool child. Areas of development are:



CREATIVITY ...

varied art media, drawing, easel opportunities, playdoh, dramatic interpretation, and imaginative play.

LANGUAGE SKILLS ...

verbal interaction with peers and adults, encouragement to express him/herself verbally, finger plays, rhymes, stories, and sharing times.

MUSIC APPRECIATION ...

singing, dancing, musical games, rhythms, listening to music, instruments.

LARGE & SMALL MUSCLE BUILDING ...

manipulative toys, scissor cutting skills, climbing equipment, riding toys, slides, balls, seed and water tables.

INTELLECTUAL STIMULATION ...

cognitive toys, science experiments, readiness work, problem solving.

SOCIAL SKILLS ...

learning to share, cooperation, responsibility, learning to accept and appreciate differences in others.

SELF-ESTEEM ...

learning to respect, trust and like her/himself; developing positive attitudes toward others; and building self-confidence by experiencing success.

Enrollment

Our preschool will accept children from three years of age to children who have not reached six years of age by September 1.

We do not have diaper-changing facilities; therefore, all students must be toilet trained before starting school.

We are not equipped or staffed to serve the educationally or developmentally exceptional child. However, some provisions are feasible for children with special needs.

Hours of Operation

School is in session September - May. Sessions are held for 2 1/2 hours. We offer 2 days/week, 3 days/week, 4 days/week, and 5 days/week programs. Each family chooses which half-days they would like. Choice of days is for the entire school year.
