

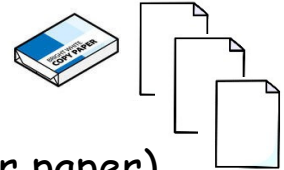

Here are **MORE** ways you can help!

Pick and Choose What Works for You!

Bulletin Boards:

- October through May.
- Change decorations each month or as needed; put decorations on and/or take off (supplies and design provided).
- Multiple boards enable you to 'adopt a board' if you wish.
- Usually done after class, but may occasionally be done during class. Sometimes helpful to do with a partner.
- Time commitment is approx. 30-60 min each time.

Room Rearranging:

- October through May.
- Set up / Change play and work areas in the classroom (supplies and floor plan provided).
- Wash & sanitize items being put away and (possibly) put items into storage.
- Get out new items for use.
- This work is most often done after school. Sometimes helpful to do with a partner.
- Time commitment is approx. 1-2 hrs each time.

Preschool Garden:

- Fall, Spring and Summer.
- "Put the garden to bed" by covering with straw before weather gets too cold and replacing it with mulch in the spring. Supplies provided, or volunteer may purchase as donation or be reimbursed.
- Planting is done by children and staff with additional volunteer help, but general help with tidying, weeding, and watering greatly appreciated, especially during the summer months.

Chick Unit:

- April and May.
- Several opportunities available, beginning with setup for incubator and ending when chicks go to the farm.
Help especially needed for brooder set-up and take-down.
- This work is most often done after school. Sometimes helpful to do with a partner.
- Time commitment varies 30-min-2+hrs.
- **Other opportunities, to help with chick care and hand washing during chick-holding, will be available after the chicks hatch.**
