CHILDREN'S MESSAGE

FIRST READING (*Beth Angerhofer*)

Psalm 118:1-2, 14-24

O give thanks to the LORD, for he is good; his steadfast love endures forever! Let Israel say, 'His steadfast love endures forever.' The LORD is my strength and my might; he has become my salvation. There are glad songs of victory in the tents of the righteous: 'The right hand of the LORD does valiantly; the right hand of the LORD is exalted; the right hand of the LORD does valiantly.' Luke 24:1-12
