St. Luke's provides a process with information and helpful content, plus a meaningful experience in this important time in your lives. Your part in this covenant is your participation in this process and cooperation with the policies set forth in this booklet. ## Our process includes:

- 1. Reading, signing and returning this Covenant and your Wedding Couple Information sheet to the St. Luke's office. At that time your wedding date will be reserved for you.
- 2. Attending a Getting Started Session, and taking the <a href="Prepare/Enrich">Prepare/Enrich</a> inventory.
- 3. Meeting with a pastor for your premarital inventory (<u>Prepare</u>) feedback and ceremony planning.
- 4. Attending the Saturday Pre-marriage Retreat. The retreat addresses communication, conflict resolution, intimacy, family systems and dreams for your future.
