As forward we travel from light in to light.

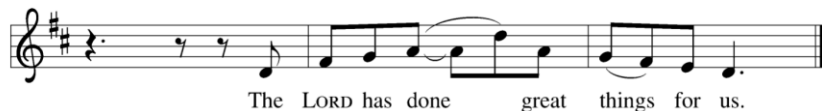
Verse 2
